4	Music Around The World 2	In this unit, pupils explore the music of a different country each week, learning about the culture and music of that country, using the language of that country, and learning a traditional song. Countries covered – Jamaica, Mexico, France, China and Australia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perform solo and as a part of a group • Recall sounds • Listen with attention to detail • Appreciated and understand music of different traditions • Understand the history of music
	The Blues	Pupils learn about the 12 bar blues. They learn about the origins of the blues, its musical structure and compose a blues in small groups using tuned instruments and percussion.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing and play musically with confidence and control • Perform solo and as part of a group • Understand composition • Understand musical structures • Appreciate and understand music of different traditions
	BBC Ten Pieces 2	This unit explores more of the BBC Ten Pieces that we not covered in BBC Ten Pieces 1. The pupils learn about the composer, the piece and it's wider context, and then do a reflection activity each week based on the piece – these activities include improvisation, composition and learning arrangements of the pieces.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reproduce sounds from aural memory • Improvise • Recall sounds • Play from staff notation • Understand composition • Organise and manipulate musical ideas • Listen with attention to detail • Appreciate and understand music of different traditions • Understand the history of music
