



Year 3 Home Learning

In Year 3 home learning is given out every *Friday* and must be returned to class by the following *Wednesday*. We hope parents will support their children in ensuring that homework is completed and returned on the following Wednesday. If there are any problems or issues please let your class teacher know in advance.

Each week, home learning will consist of: Individualised Spellings/Maths/Reading and English. All subjects are directly linked to what we have been studying that week.

Reading

We encourage pupils to read as often as possible and for at least **20 minutes per evening**. The pupil should record a brief sentence in their ***Home School diary*** in the reading record section which should be signed by parents each week. Teachers will check their Home school diary every week and also sign it. This diary is a good way to pass any messages you need to convey to teachers and vice versa.

Spellings

Each pupil receives 5 words per week which they should learn for a weekly spelling test. These spellings are based on the pupils individualised misspelt words and the End of Year 3 spellings list from the New National curriculum.

Maths

We recommend that pupils learn their times tables and practise their math skills on **Mathletics** which can support learning in class lessons. Each child has their own password and username.

English

Pupils should endeavour to write a reading review of every book they read. Within the review they should give a short summary of what the book was about, what they thought of the book and why?
