



Year 6 Home Learning

Home learning provides children with an important opportunity to consolidate what they have learned with us at school. We expect that all children will complete these activities, to the best of their ability, and return them to school on time. We provide sufficient time for children to complete activities carefully rather than leaving all tasks for the weekend.

Please let the class teacher know if your child experienced difficulty in completing their home learning, or if an emergency at home has prevented them from completing the activities within the expected time frame.

Home Learning:

Maths: The focus for Maths home learning is the based on the skills the children are learning in their Maths lessons that week. All Maths home learning needs to be completed in the children's Maths home learning books.

Grammar: The focus for Grammar home learning is the based on the skills the children are learning in their Grammar lessons that week. All Grammar home learning needs to be completed in the children's Grammar home learning books.

Home learning is given out each **Thursday** and is due to be returned by the following **Tuesday**.

Spellings:

Each week, children will receive five spellings to take home and learn. These will be based on the end of year spellings for Year 6 and misspelt words from your child's individual learning.

New spellings will be given out every **Tuesday**, and should be learnt daily using their LSCWC (Look Say Cover Write Check). Children will then have a spelling test each **Tuesday**.

Home Reading:

Reading should be done for 20 minutes *everyday*. Children are to write a brief comment answering one of the questions on page 104 in their *Home School Diary* each day as well.

Home /school dairies are monitored and signed by the class teacher on a *weekly* basis. We ask all parents/carers to sign the *Home School Diary* on a *weekly* basis as well. The diary is a useful means of communication between home and school so please check the diary regularly.
