



8. Who are the other people providing services to children with SEND in this school?

School provision

- Teachers responsible for teaching SEND groups/individuals.
- Teaching Assistants and HLTAs mainly working with either individual children or small groups.
- English interventions:
 - Rapid Phonics
 - Letters and Sounds
 - Catch-Up Literacy (1:1 intervention).
 - Booster Reading Programme
 - Inference Training
 - 1st Class @Writing
- Maths interventions:
 - 1st Class @Numeracy
 - Springboard
 - Numicon (a multi-sensory approach to maths)
 - Catch-Up Numeracy (1:1 intervention) is delivered by teachers and teaching assistants during specified lessons and small group or individual sessions, according to need.
- Speech and Language interventions:
 - Social Skills
 - Social stories
 - Chatterbox
 - Picture Exchange communication System used (PECS)
 - Talking Box
 - Social skills groups
 - Box clever
 - Colourful Semantics
 - Lego Therapy
- Place 2 Be and Place 2 Talk offering support for children with emotional and social development needs
