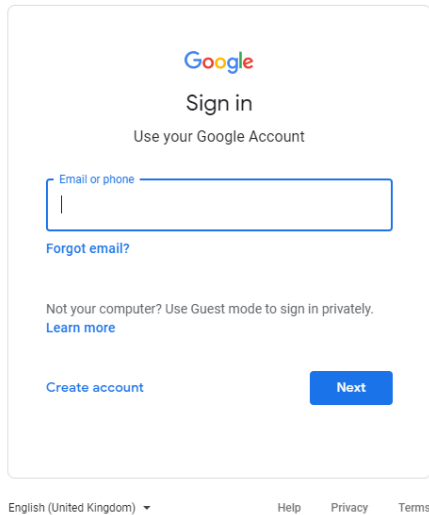




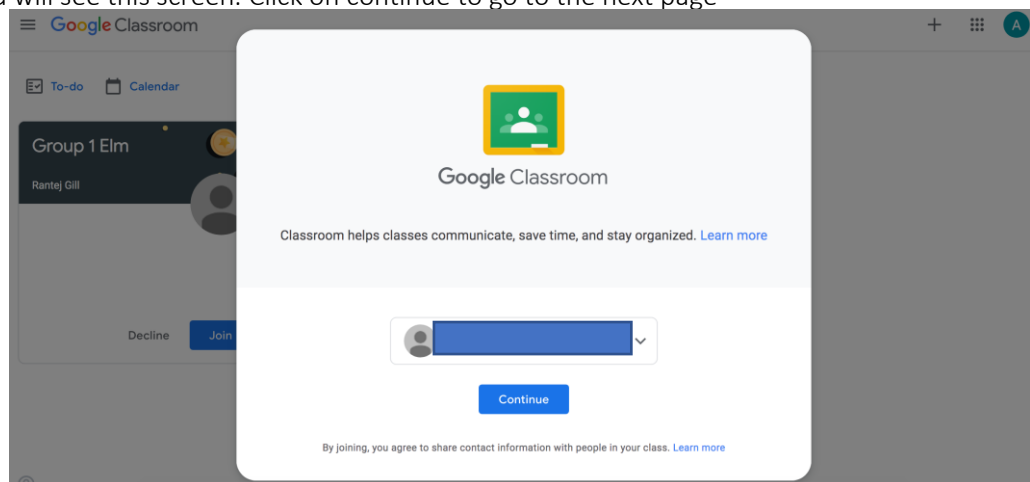

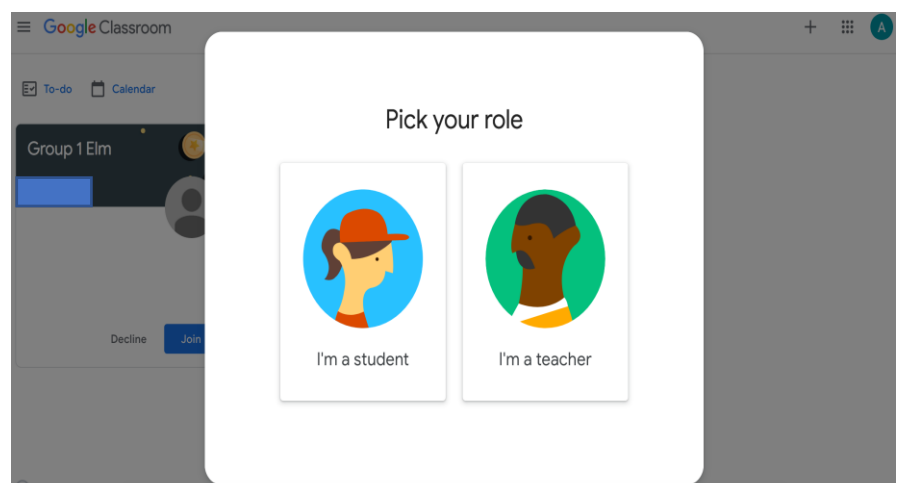
A. In the address bar, type accounts.google.com. Type in your Ravenor email and password.



B. After you have logged on, you will see this screen. Click on continue to go to the next page

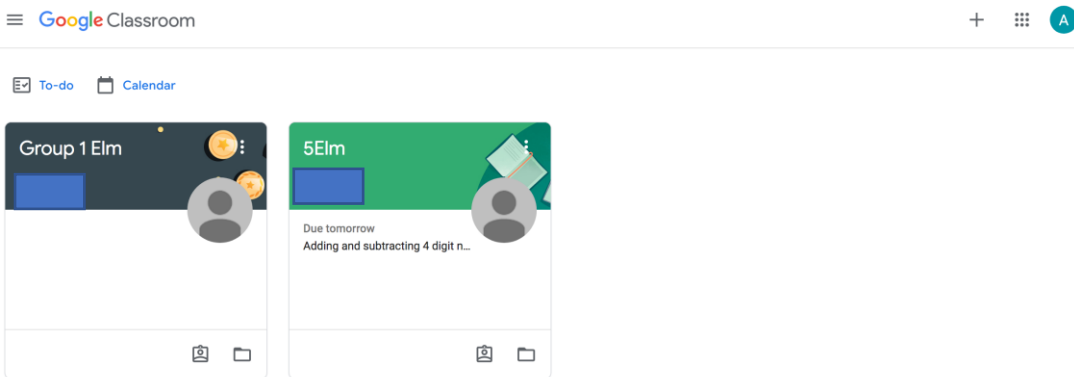
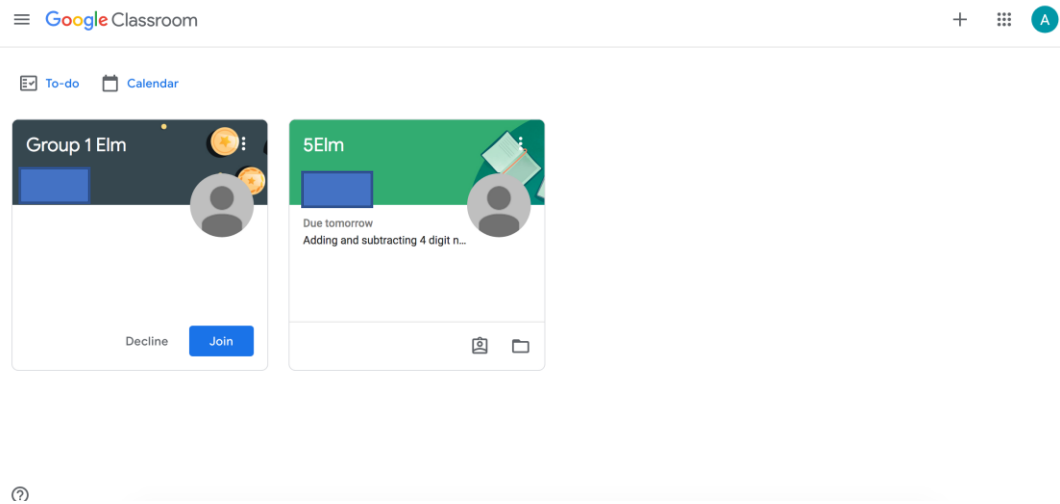


C. Once you have clicked continue, you will be shown two options. Make sure to click on 'I'm a student' tab.



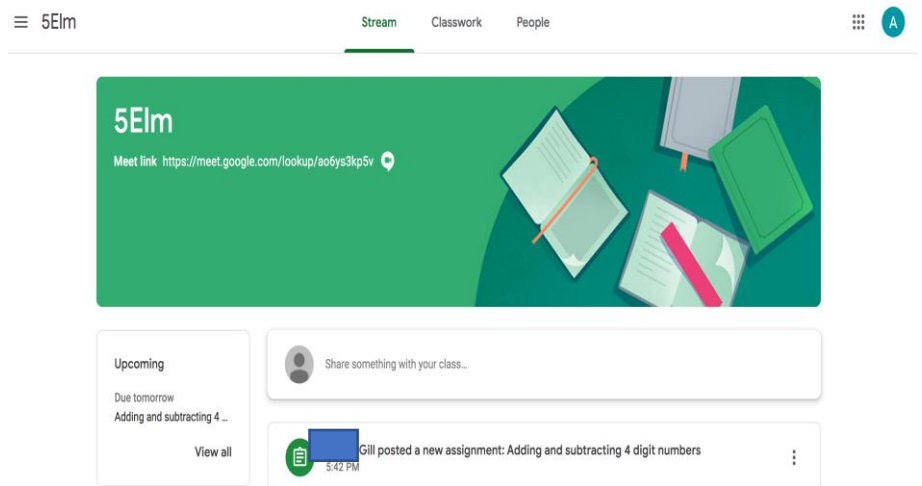
Steps B&C will only have to be done once.

- A. Once you have logged in, you will see this screen. Your class will already be set up and if you have been asked to join a group you will need to click 'Join'.

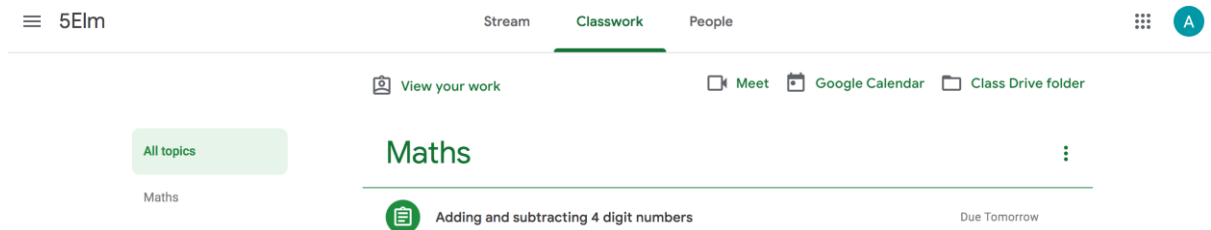


- B. After clicking 'Join' you will be able to access your class and group portal.

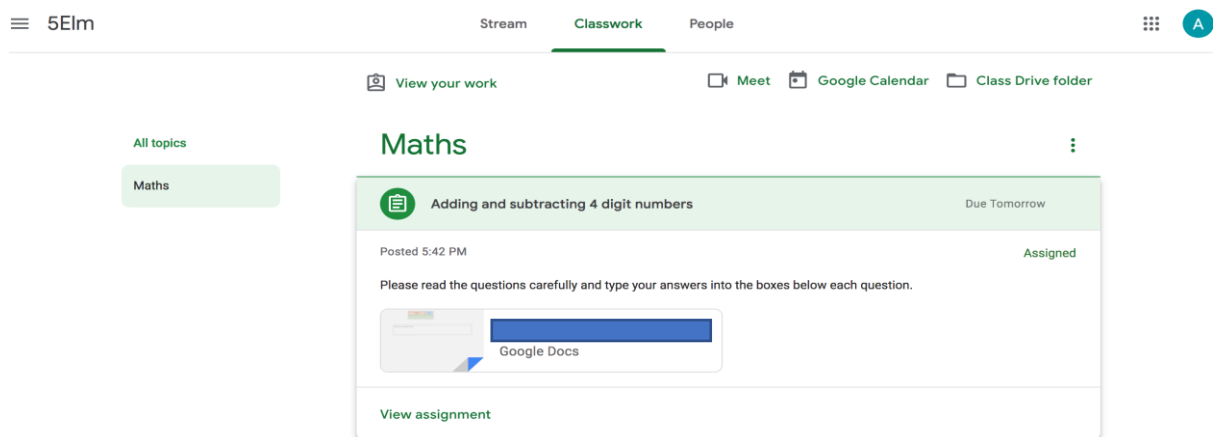
- C. Once you have clicked your class or group's name, you will be taken to the stream page. Here you can see what work has been allocated and if anything was posted in the stream.



- D. For you to access your assignments, you will need to click on 'Classwork'. From here you can see all your assignments split up in to topics.

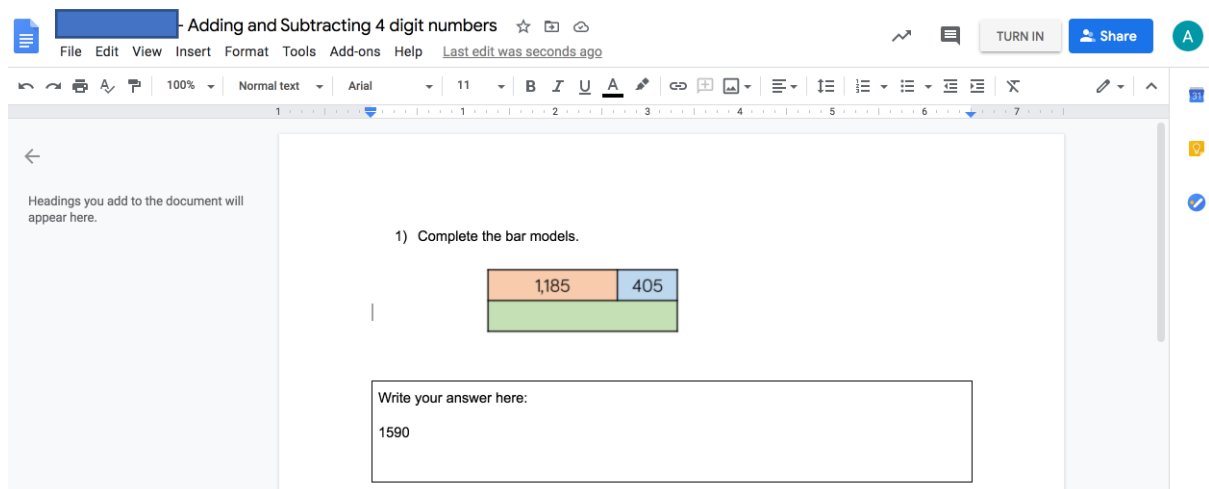


- E. Click on the assignment and click on the document tab. This will bring your assignment up on a different tab.

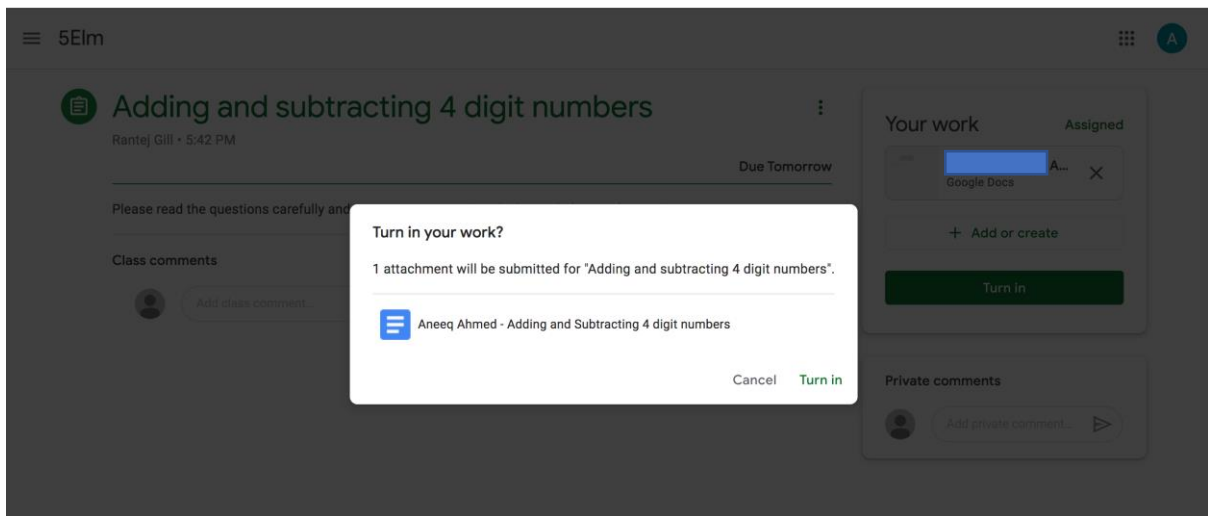


Completing a Google Doc assignment

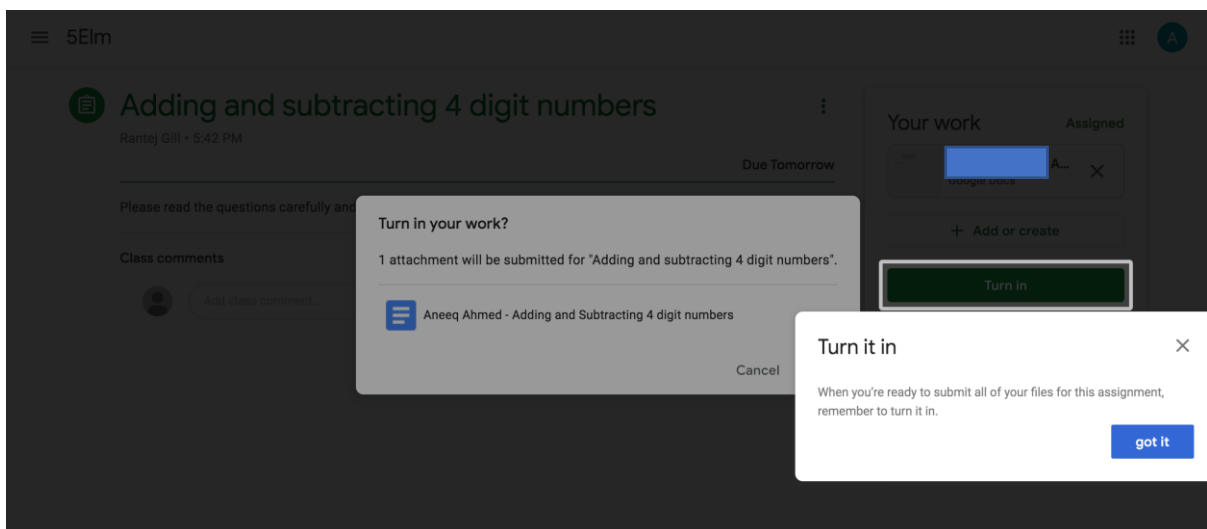
- A. You will be shown your assignment. Here you can type in your answers into the boxes provided. Once you have finished your assignment, click 'Turn in' on the top right and your teacher will be sent your answers.



B. The first time you click on 'Turn in', you will be shown a hint tab.



Once you have clicked 'got it', you will be able to click 'Turn in'. This will cause your work to be sent back to your teacher for reviewing.



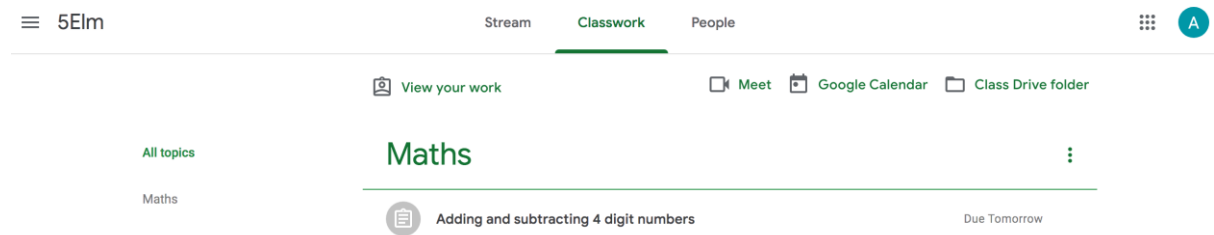
- C. After clicking 'Turn in', you will have the chance to do the following:
1. Unsubmit – here you will have the chance to unsubmit your work, if you feel you have made a mistake or if you have clicked 'Turn in' by mistake.
 2. Private comment – here you will be able send your teacher a private comment regarding the work.
